McGowan Institute for Regenerative Medicine Associate Director [Rocky Tuan, PhD](#), has been appointed Distinguished Professor of Orthopaedic Surgery in the University of Pittsburgh School of Medicine effective September 1, 2014. Dr. Tuan's appointment was recommended by Dean Arthur Levine and Provost Patricia Beeson and approved by Chancellor Mark Nordenberg.
